Since having my first DSLR camera in my A Levels I've never looked back. Starting to shoot weddings as a beginner in 2018, to then shooting over 30 weddings a year in 2023!



# Your Experience



1

Let's have a chat! We can meet in person or have a zoom call. If we can talk about your plans and get to know one another a little better we'll know if we're the right fit.

2

Now you've signed the contract and paid your deposit you're all booked in! Feel free to get in touch at any time, even if it's not photography related.

3

6 months before I'll be in touch regarding your engagement shoot. The images will be delivered within 6 weeks so why not use them at the wedding?!

4

4 months before I send you a group suggestions list, to help you organise and plan ahead so you have less to think about on the day.

5

8 weeks before the big day I'll resend your wedding questionnaire to be updated on all the details I'll need to know. We can always meet for another coffee if you fancy it.

6

Final payment is taken a month before the wedding, you'll be sent a reminder 20 days earlier, so don't stress.

7

On the last week before the big day, I'll be in touch to check everything is all good and ready to go.

# WHAT TO EXPECT . . .

Every wedding day is different, but saying that, it's typical that most days will follow with some key moments.

No matter your plans I'm happy to go with the flow and I'm always excited to experience something new.

Here are some key moments and how I tend to work them:

## MORNING PREP



For morning prep I like to give myself 2 hours. So if you're getting ready in a separate location to your ceremony it gives enough time to accommodate travel. With 2 hours it also gives me a good amount of time to get all the little details, as well as you and your wedding party getting your glam on!

Something to think about in the morning is whether or not to have a first look. These can be done with your parents, wedding party or even your partner. Seeing loved ones before the ceremony can help calm those nerves.



If you'd both love to get your prep shots please do consider a second photographer, as much as I'd love to be in two places at once, having that second shooter capture the pre-ceremony moments of your partner makes all the difference. Also, they're super handy to have the rest of the day for different angles, more candids and extra photos!



## CEREMONY

The part where you get married!  
During your ceremony I'm always non intrusive, whilst capturing all the best bits.  
My top tip is to always check in with your registrar/vicar/official to make sure they have no restrictions for your photographer or videographer.

## CONFETTI!

Oh boy do I love confetti! What a fun way to celebrate you've just got married!

If you can I always highly recommend biodegradable paper confetti, this always falls beautifully and slowly, getting the best shots for you - look up Flutter Darlings. But, if you aren't in to confetti or your venue has restrictions bubbles are also just as fun, buy yourself some bubble guns and they'll work great!



## GROUP SHOTS

This is never anyones favourite part of the day, but I promise with a well planned group list in advance and a little bit of fun; you won't hate them as much as you expect to.

Relaxed and natural is my approach to group shots, but if you'd prefer a hint of creativity then we'll see what we can do!  
See who can get the beer first?!





# Couples Photos

Now it's your time to shine! After plenty of photos so far, you'll both be pros at having your photos taken - no matter how shy and awkward you tell me you are!

During your day if possible and time allows, I'd love to take you out on two sessions.

The first will be after your group photos and before food, the second (if we're lucky) will be during GOLDEN HOUR! This not only allows you some time alone as a newly married couple, but it allows us to get more photos with different backdrops and lighting.

(It also helps us work around the temperamental British weather!)

This is time for you, no forced posing on my end, just have a chat and be yourselves, these make for the best shots.





## SPEECHES


Well if you want emotional pictures, whether that's laughing or crying, speeches are the moment. For me I find that these can be some of the best moments for candid shots, so you'll see me moving around a lot but I'll still stay unintrusive.

## DANCING

One of my absolute favourite parts of the day is the dancing! By this point of the day all your guests are so much more comfortable with me (the booze probably helps) and people really start to let loose! This makes for some fantastic candid shots!

Once you've had your first dance, I suggest roping in a parent (or two) to join you in the dance floor, as they make for some beautiful memories! Also, a new favourite of mine is a second dress for the bride, allowing them to be more comfortable to get their dancing shoes on.

Depending on what your package allows, typically I'm with you for an hour after the first dance. Meaning I capture some of the craziness before it gets too out of hand.

# After The Wedding

Whilst you're still dancing away,  
I'll be at home uploading all your  
photos to my hard drives making  
sure they're safe and sound.

2

Depending on which package you choose,  
you'll receive some sneak peeks within 3  
to 7 days. These will fill your wedding  
blues before receiving the full gallery.

3

12 weeks after the big day, you'll  
receive an email from me as it'll be time  
for you to look at your full gallery!  
All of which you can download as many  
as you please.

4

No matter if you've received a USB  
with your box, I always urge you to save  
you images in as many places as possible.  
They will be on your gallery for 12  
months, but do save them online and  
your own devices.

5

Share your images as you please!  
You can share your gallery with family  
and friends via the gallery link, saving  
you having to send the USB to them.

6

Once all is done, I'd love for you to  
leave me a review. I'll always send you  
the link to save you time searching.  
It's always appreciated.





# How To Book?

1

Fill out your details on the “Contact” page on my website.  
I’ll get back to as soon as possible.

2

Let’s sort a date for a coffee to have a chat, or if that’s not ideal then we can have a zoom call. Then we can get to know one another and see if I’m the fit for you.

3


When you’re happy that I’m your photographer, I’ll send you through a quote including a contract & questionnaire.

Non-refundable deposits are 20% of your package price.  
An invoice will come through once you’ve accepted the quote

You’re all booked in! Once the contract and deposit have been received on my end you’ll be officially all booked in!  
I can’t wait to be there on your day!
